#### EOP Recommendation Request Deadline - January 31, 2024

If an applicant requests a letter of recommendation for the [Educational Opportunity Program \(EOP\)](#), Cal State Apply will automatically select a default deadline date two weeks from the date the applicant submits the request (e.g., if the recommendation request is submitted on January 1, the EOP deadline date automatically selects January 15). The default date cannot be changed. However, if the default deadline date passes, a recommender will still be able to submit a recommendation. All recommendations must be submitted by the documents deadline of **January 31, 2024**, unless noted otherwise on the [EOP Admission by Term and Deadlines](#) page.

#### Cal State Apply Coupon Code Requests


### Reminders and Clarifications

## Financial Aid

### Free Application for Federal Student Aid and California Dream Act Application

The Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) form and California Dream Act Application (CADAA) opened on December 31, 2023. As a result of the FAFSA soft launch, the form was initially available periodically, however, the U.S. Department of Education [recently announced](#) that the FAFSA form is now available 24/7.

The state deadline to file these applications is April 2, 2024, however, the CSU encourages students to submit by March 2, 2024.
