More than half of the institutions of the California State University system have received a new Carnegie designation known as "Research Colleges and Universities" or "RCU," by the American Council on Education and the Carnegie Foundation for the Advancement of Teaching. Twenty-one of 23 CSU universities have now been recognized by the classification framework.
