- 47% of Sac State students reported struggling with food insecurity.
 - (over 14,000)
- 12% of Sac State reported experiencing homelessness one or more time in the last year.
 - (over 3,000)

“Students who reported food insecurity, homelessness, or both also experienced physical and mental health consequences that were associated with lower academic achievement.” (Crutchfield & Maguire, 2018)


